



Safe to say

Through Safe2Say Something (S2SS), students, staff, parents/guardians, and community members will be able to submit an anonymous tip through the Safe2Say Something system in one of three ways:

- A mobile app, which is available for download on Apple and Android devices for free
- The Safe2Say Something website, www.safe2saypa.org
- A 24/7 phone line, 1-844-SAF2SAY (1-844-723-2729)

Once the report is made, the following steps will take place:

- The crisis center, staffed by the Office of the Attorney General, will review, assess, and process all submissions.
- The crisis center will send all submissions to a team of STBCA administrators and/or law enforcement officials for intervention.
- If needed, the crisis center may contact the tipster anonymously through the app.
